Scholarship Application

General Qualifications

Applicants must be...

- a dependent of, spouse of, or an active KEA member
- a high school senior or college student

... who is planning to attend, or is already attending, an accredited post-secondary college, university, technical/vocational institute, or trade school.

The scholarship may only be used to cover tuition costs.

The first half of the scholarship amount will be awarded after the second quarter or semester of attendance. The second half of the scholarship will be awarded after the successful completion of the final quarter or semester.

Application Process

- 1. Complete the scholarship application.
- 2. Present two current and dated confidential letters of recommendation from 1) a teacher or professor at an accredited school, and 2) a member of the community.
- 3. Provide an official high school transcript or a current grade sheet from a college.

Requirements for an Award

- The applicant must meet all the general qualifications.
- The application must be complete and submitted by the deadline (see below).

Selections will be made based on meeting the requirements, responding to the questions below, presenting the letters of recommendation, and receiving the consensus of committee members you exemplify a commitment to excellence and lifelong learning.

Deadline

Applicants must have all required documents on file in the KEA office by **May 1, 2024**. All applicants will receive a letter of appreciation. Those selected for scholarships will receive written notification.

Award Access

Half the amount of each scholarship will be presented to the family of the applicant when proof of enrollment is provided following 1) the second quarter or semester, and 2) the final quarter or semester.
